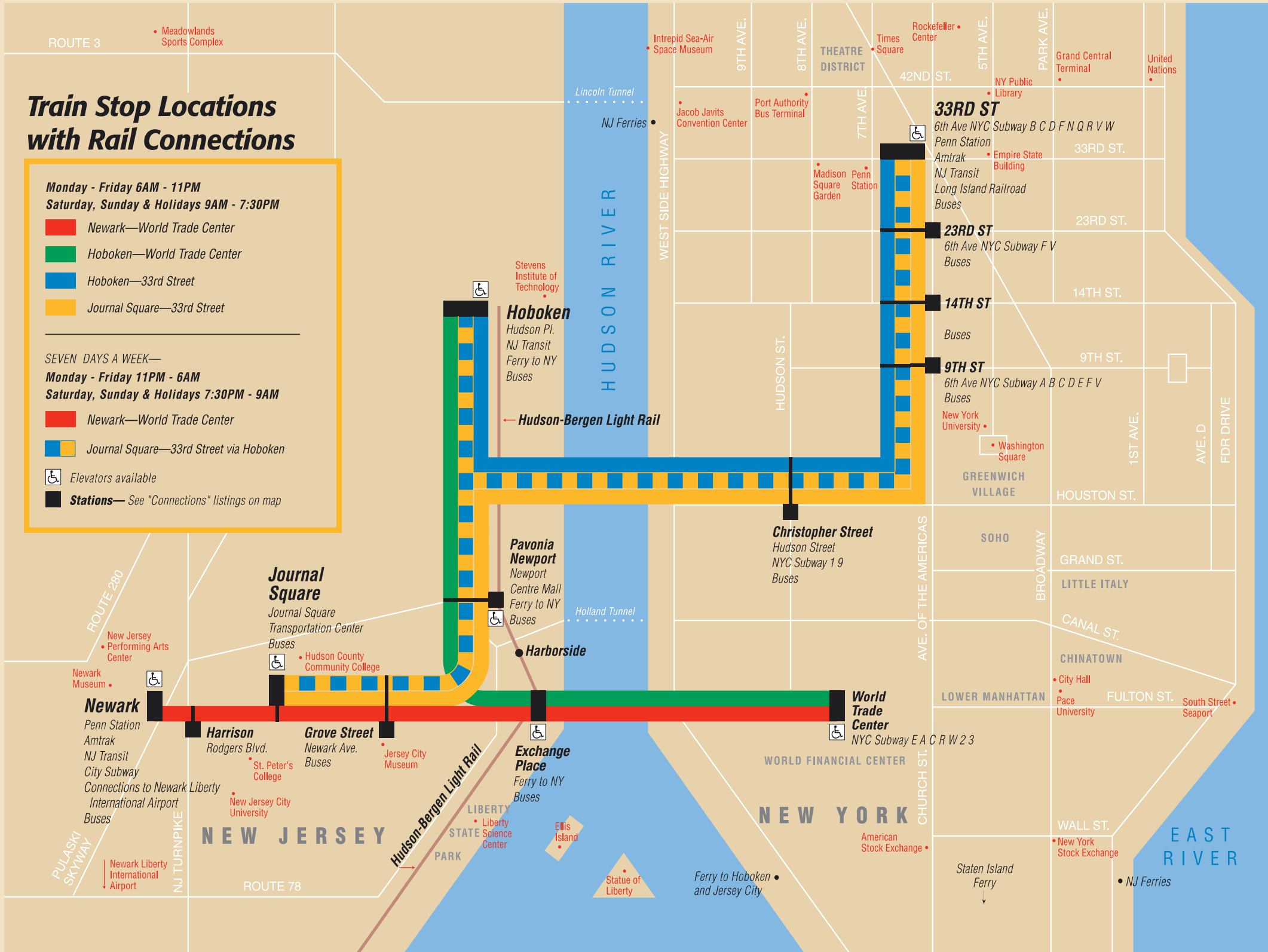

Service Notes

Fare: \$1.50 for all trips. Children age 5 and under ride free. Senior Citizens age 65 or older with a PATH Senior Fare card pay \$1.00 for all trips. 11-trip QuickCards cost \$15 and offer customers a price per trip of \$1.36. 20-trip QuickCards cost \$24; 40-trip QuickCards cost \$48. 20-and 40-trip QuickCards offer customers a price per trip of \$1.20.

Connections / Responsibilities: PATH schedules are planned for convenient transfer to trains at Newark and Hoboken. Customers are advised to allow a **minimum of seven minutes** to transfer between PATH and other carriers at all PATH stations. However, connections with other carriers cannot be guaranteed. PATH cannot assume responsibility from errors in schedule, delayed or canceled trains or failure to make connections. Trains may depart ahead of schedule. Schedules subject to change without notice.

Weekend Construction / Maintenance: Due to weekend construction/maintenance, weekend schedules may be subject to change. Call PATH's toll-free number (800) 234-PATH (7284) for updated schedule information or www.panynj.gov.

Holiday Schedules: Sunday schedules on New Year's Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Special supplemental service on Independence Day. All other holidays on regular schedule.

Accessibility: Seven stations are fully accessible for customers with disabilities and provide elevator access between platforms and street levels as well as other amenities. Please see PATH Map and look for designation for these stations.

Lost and Found: Located at the PATH Police Desk in the Journal Square Transportation Center (201) 216-2677 or (212) 435-2611.

No Smoking: Smoking is prohibited on trains and in stations. Violators are subject to prosecution.

No Eating and Drinking: No person shall eat any food or drink any beverage on the station platforms or while aboard any rail car operated by PATH.

Bicycles: No bicycles are allowed on PATH property or cars on weekdays between 6:30 AM and 9:30 AM and between 3:30 PM and 6:30 PM. At other times no more than two bicycles are permitted in a rail car and bicycles are not permitted in the first rail car of a train.

Animals: Service animals for disabled customers and small domestic animals in a secure carrying case are permitted. No other animals are allowed.

Agents are available at most stations weekdays during the morning peak and weeknights during the evening peak. Agents are also available PATHuesday mornings at the 33rd Street station and at the temporary World Trade Center station.
